PMI Agile Certified Practitioner Course (PMI-ACP)[®]

The PMI-ACP[®] certification is designed for project managers that are using agile approaches, have good collaboration skills, eagerly embrace complexity and thrive on rapid response times.

The PMI Agile Certified Practitioner (PMI-ACP)[®] formally recognizes knowledge of agile principles and skill with agile techniques.

Course Overview

The primary aim of this course is to provide project managers wishing to write the PMI ACP® exam with a structured preparation forum and a mutual network of support from ProjectLink. The PMI-ACP® is PMI's fastest growing certification. Organizations that are highly agile and responsive to market dynamics complete more of their projects successfully than their slower-moving counterparts – 75 percent versus 56 percent – as shown in PMI's 2015 Pulse of the Profession® report.
